- **Your school may enter up to two movies (please contact us if you intend on entering).**
- **Movie must be entered by April 1st 2012 for screening**
- **Videos must be submitted in a standard definition (16:9 aspect ratio) DVD or USB format (keep the original in case of damage in shipment)**
